Requirements: Age 21

Valid VA driver's license

Must be able to possess legally a firearm

Preferred: Current VA law enforcement certification

Positive prior law enforcement or corrections experience

U.S. military veteran or reserve duty status

College degree

Applicants are subject to a background check. Preliminary offer of appointment subject to physical examination.

Duties: Uniformed patrol response to citizen complaints; preliminary criminal investigations; traffic enforcement; criminal arrests; civil process service and court security; and other assigned tasks. Shift work, holidays, and weekends required. Occasional overnight travel may be involved.

Benefits: Starting salary \$34,000 (negotiable); health insurance; VRS retirement; uniforms and equipment, including vehicle. Basic and in-service training provided.
